

Criteria for Pathway Completion

Minimum Criteria for a Pathway Completion (Blue Honor Cord)

- Be on track for graduation
- Participate in a minimum of 4 Work-Based Learning experiences. It may include the following but not limited to:
 - ✓ Job Shadowing
 - ✓ Resume Workshops and Mock Interviews
 - ✓ Guest Speakers
 - ✓ Participation in a Career Technical Student Organization (e.g. HOSA, FBLA, FCCLA, Skills USA)
- Complete 2 inter-disciplinary project related to the Pathway with a satisfactory grade.
- Complete one culminating experience of student choice – portfolio or senior defense
- Complete a minimum of 2 CTE courses in a Pathway (One CTE concentrator and one CTE capstone) in the SAME Pathway with a letter grade C or above. *(Please see chart below)*

Criteria for the CTE Seal of Distinction Pathway Honor (CTE Medal)

- Enroll in a Pathway for a minimum of 3 years
- Complete the minimal criteria of a CTE Pathway Completer AND the additional components of the following:
 - ✓ Complete at least 1 Dual Enrollment College course with a letter grade C or above
 - ✓ Received at least 1 Industry recognized certification
 - ✓ Complete a minimum of **80 hours** (or **two 40 hours experiences**) paid/unpaid internship (working from home or onsite) with “Meet Standards” evaluation from the employer/supervisor.
 - ✓ Complete a minimum of three years of CTE courses (one or two CTE Introductory, one CTE concentrator, and one CTE Capstone) in the SAME Pathway with a letter grade C or above. *(Please see chart below)*

Alternative Internship Experiences Options

You may use the following alternative experiences to count as internship hours:

- Part-Time Jobs
- Service-learning experiences or business focused projects with business partner/organization (e.g. Youth Health Corps, etc.)
- Volunteerism experience in a non-profit organization (e.g. Central California SPCA)
- CTSO State Officers Positions
- Alternative Internship Options Must Be:
 - ✓ Total of **80 hours** in **one company/organization** (or **two 40-hour experiences in each company/organization**)
 - ✓ Completion of the Internship Assessment by the student’s mentor/supervisor at the end of the alternative experience.
 - ✓ An Alternative Internship Form must be completed and signed by the students, parent/guardian, and supervisor
